

Awards and Honor

It is the policy of the Atlantic Life Safety & Emergency Services to appropriately recognize members of the Agency, who perform an act of distinct heroism or who provide an outstanding service to the Department, or to the public safety of the community.

Awards will be presented annually in, or during, an appropriate ceremony by the Director of Emergency Services or his representative. There is no limit placed on the number of awards that may be made to any one individual or the number awarded, in total, during any one year.

Medal of Honor To receive the Medal of Honor, the recipient must be a member of the agency who, in the performance of duty while on a call, under extrem hazardous conditions, in which the member is confronted with risk, and has full knowledge of that risk, performs an act of conspicuous heroism which furthers the highest traditions of emergency service. This honor will be bestowed upon nomination, review from the Board of Directors and approval from Director of Emergency Services. Medal of Valor To receive the Medal of Valor, the recipient must be a member of the agency who, in the performance of duty while on a call, under hazardous conditions, in which the member is conforated with imminent personal risk, but had no knowledge of that risk, performs an act of conspicuous heroism which furthers the highest traditions of emergency service. This honor will be bestowed upon nomination, review from the Board of Directors and approval from Director of Emergency Services. Medal of Bravery To receive the Medal of Bravery, the recipient must be a member of the agency who, in the performance of duty while on a call, performs an act of distinguished bravery and stamina in adverse conditions of fine, environment, weather, or materials. 	leadership in field training and mentoring of members of the agency. This honor will be bestowed
	upon nomination and approval from Director of Emergency Services.

	The Certified Hazardous Materials Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to acknowledge expertise in handling hazardous materials. Member must hold Hazardous Materials
	Technician Level I (Awareness & Operations) Certification or Higher. This honor will be bestowed
	upon approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	Certified Firefighter Commendation
	The Certified Firefighter Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to acknowledge

	acknowledge expertise in technical rescue operations. Members must hold Technical Rescuer
	Certification. This honor will be bestowed upon approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	Certified Law Enforcement Officer Commendation
	The Certified Law Enforcement Officer Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to
	acknowledge expertise in law enforcement operations. Members must hold Law Enforcement Certification. This honor will be bestowed upon approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	Certified Instructor Commendation The Certified Instructor Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to acknowledge skill
	and readiness to provide training and mentoring. Member must hold certification as an Emergency
	Services and/or Public Safety Instructor. This honor will be bestowed upon approval from the
	Director of Emergency Services.

	The Certified Search & Rescue Technician is awarded to a member of the agency to acknowledge
	expertise in search and rescue operations. Members must hold National Association for Search &
	Rescue Technician III Certification of Higher. This honor will be bestowed upon approval from the
	Director of Emergency Services.
	Certified Dive Rescue Technician Commendation
	The Certified Dive Rescue Technician Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to
	acknowledge expertise in dive rescue operations. Members must hold Dive Rescue Certification.
	This honor will be bestowed upon approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	United States Armed Forces Commendation
	The United States Armed Forces Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to
	acknowledge honorable service in the United Armed Forces. Members must be active duty, reserve
	status, retired, or honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces. This
	honor will be bestowed upon approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	Honor Guard Commendation
	The Honor Guard Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to acknowledge service as
	a member of an honor guard detail on behalf of the agency. This honor will be bestowed upon
	approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	Natural Disaster Response Commendation
	The Natural Disaster Response Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to
	acknowledge service during a natural disaster as declared by a State of Emergency Order. This
	honor will be bestowed upon approval from the Director of Emergency Services.
	Life Member Commendation
	The Life Member Commendation is awarded to a member of the agency to acknowledge recipient
	of life membership to the agency. This honor will be bestowed upon approval from the Director of
	Emergency Services.
